Councilwoman Hahn Provides Makeover for Wilmington Park

Councilwoman Janice Hahn today announced the renovation of the East Wilmington Pocket Park, at the intersection of Watson and O Street in Wilmington. Plans include demolition of the old play pit and equipment, to be replaced with new equipment and a brand new rubber play surface. New swings, slides, and climbing structures will be installed, as well as new ADA-approved drinking fountains and benches.

The park's overhaul is one of several recent improvement projects in Wilmington undertaken by the Councilwoman. Other projects have included replacement of sidewalks on Cruces Street, tree trimming, new stop signs and community clean-ups.

"This park was old and dilapidated -- the community deserves better. This much-needed makeover and all new equipment will give the kids in Wilmington a safe and fun place to play in the neighborhood," said Councilwoman Hahn.

The park renovation is expected to be completed by October of this year. The park is currently closed during construction.
